

## Description:

- A tall tree of the northern forests with a spreading canopy
- Typically for trees of that region it is frost tender and prefers deep rich soil
- The leaves are a glossy green on the upper surface and paler underneath. Veins are prominent and the newer leaves are covered in brown hairs

## Fruit & Flowers:

- Taraire have small yellowish flowers in spring to late summer
- Purple and ovoid, the fruit look like plums. Much loved by the pigeons

## Pests / Diseases:

- Taraire do not have any significant pests or diseases but like most forest species suffer from grazing possums *Uses*:
- The fruit, like those of the karaka, were a food source. The kernels were cooked, however unlike the karaka, the flesh itself was not palatable
