Recently launched flyandplant.com was established to provide air travellers, who think globally but want to act locally, with an easy way to support their neighbourhood reforestation projects with funds for indigenous tree planting and the enhancement of biodiversity.

Aircraft engines release, amongst other pollutants, carbon dioxide (CO₂) which is seriously damaging the earth's climate.

A one hour flight releases approximately 100 kg of (CO₂) for each passenger!

Fly and Plant directs 100% of donations to local projects involved in reforesting neighbourhood wastelands with indigenous plants.

These projects are run by local residents and/or environmental groups and often enjoy support of city authorities and other sponsors.

All projects help biodiversity by promoting the variety and abundance of local species of plants and animals.
