IN THE CASE OF AN ACCIDENT OR MEDICAL EMERGENCY: ⇒ Make sure it is safe for you to intervene, and that all uninjured parties are safe ⇒ First Aider to administer First Aid ⇒ Call 111 if necessary and ask for ambulance services ⇒ Coordinate and reassure non-injured parties, and ensure that the injured person(s) are not crowded Send a runner back to the Motuihe Trust nursery area to inform them of the incident. Emergency IN THE CASE OF FIRE OR OTHER EMERGENCY: ⇒ Immediately ensure that all teachers, supervisors and Group Leaders are aware of the emergency ⇒ Proceed as safely and quickly as possible to the assembly point (Wharf bay or Ocean Beach near the wharf, or in case of tsunami, the trig.)

- ⇒ Group Leaders or teachers are to do a roll call to account for all persons in their group.
- ⇒ Everyone is to stay in groups at the assembly point until the "All Clear" is given by the Motuihe Trust.
