

MRS. E. J. BROWNING.

Mrs. E. J. Browning, who succumbed to influenza at Motuihi Island yesterday, was the wife of Lieutenant E. J. Browning, Assistant-Adjutant-General, Auckland District Headquarters, and the only daughter of Mr. and Mrs. G. V. Kemsley, of Waikanae. She was engaged as a volunteer nurse at the Technical College temporary hospital during the epidemic, and when a call was made for nurses for the Makura patients on Motuihi, she immediately offered her services, and proceeded to the island last Sunday week. The funeral took place at Motuihi yesterday.
